PBGF Hall of Fame Criteria for Hounds

A minimum of 100 points is required to be eligible for nomination into the PBGF, Inc. Hall of Fame. Awards earned while the organization was the PBGA shall be considered for qualification for the PBGF Hall of Fame. Once a hound has achieved the minimum number of points and if the committee recommends the hound, the final consideration rests with the PBGF membership which has the voting power to induct the nominees. No hound is guaranteed admittance into the Hall of Fame based on the accumulation of 100 points. The emphasis should be on PBGF participation, contribution to the betterment of the breed, and accomplishment in field trialing. Each criteria listed is cumulative, unless noted as a one-time point only. Note: Dates and proper documentation must accompany the nomination form.
